

## National 4-H Curriculum Peer Reviewer Job Description

### Overview

Peer Reviewers are Land Grant University Faculty or Extension professionals who volunteer their time to support this unique national effort. Reviewers include 4-H youth development educators and specialists as well as other professionals familiar with the field of youth development.

### Responsibilities

- Review curriculum/activities submitted within three weeks.
- Make recommendations based on how well the curriculum/activities meet the established criteria.
- Provide specific comments that will be returned to the author.
- Serve as a Peer Reviewer for a minimum of one year.

### Qualifications

- Candidates must have prior review experience, preferably on the state or national level. This may include reviews of conference workshops, grants, articles, evaluations, programs, curricula, or other review experience.
