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2) th and Adults in Action (YAA) focuses on ueveloping leadership and life skills in Nebraska City youth. Our goal is to help youth work in partnership with adults to improve their own lives and the community in which they live.

In March of 2006, Scotts Bluff County youth leaders and UNL Extension Staff provided YAA members with six hours of training. The training centered on ways that youth and adults can work together. The youth learned how to conduct a community forum and then practiced their new skills.
