Lesson Study Reflection Tool: Graffiti Wall Reflections!

Graffiti Wall Instructions:

1. Hang one or more pieces of flip chart paper on a wall.
2. Provide youth with a variety of colored markers – bold colors are recommended!
3. During the activity, ask youth to record unique observations or “ah-ha” moments they might have.
4. After the activity, encourage the youth to write reflections about what they learned during the activity, as well as how they see their new knowledge/skill applying to their everyday lives.
5. Additionally, ask the youth to record any suggestions they might have about improving the activity for other youth in the future.

*This is a great way for youth (teens love it!) to reflect upon a 4-H experience.

**Use the youths’ reflections to help improve an activity and/or the teaching of the activity.
