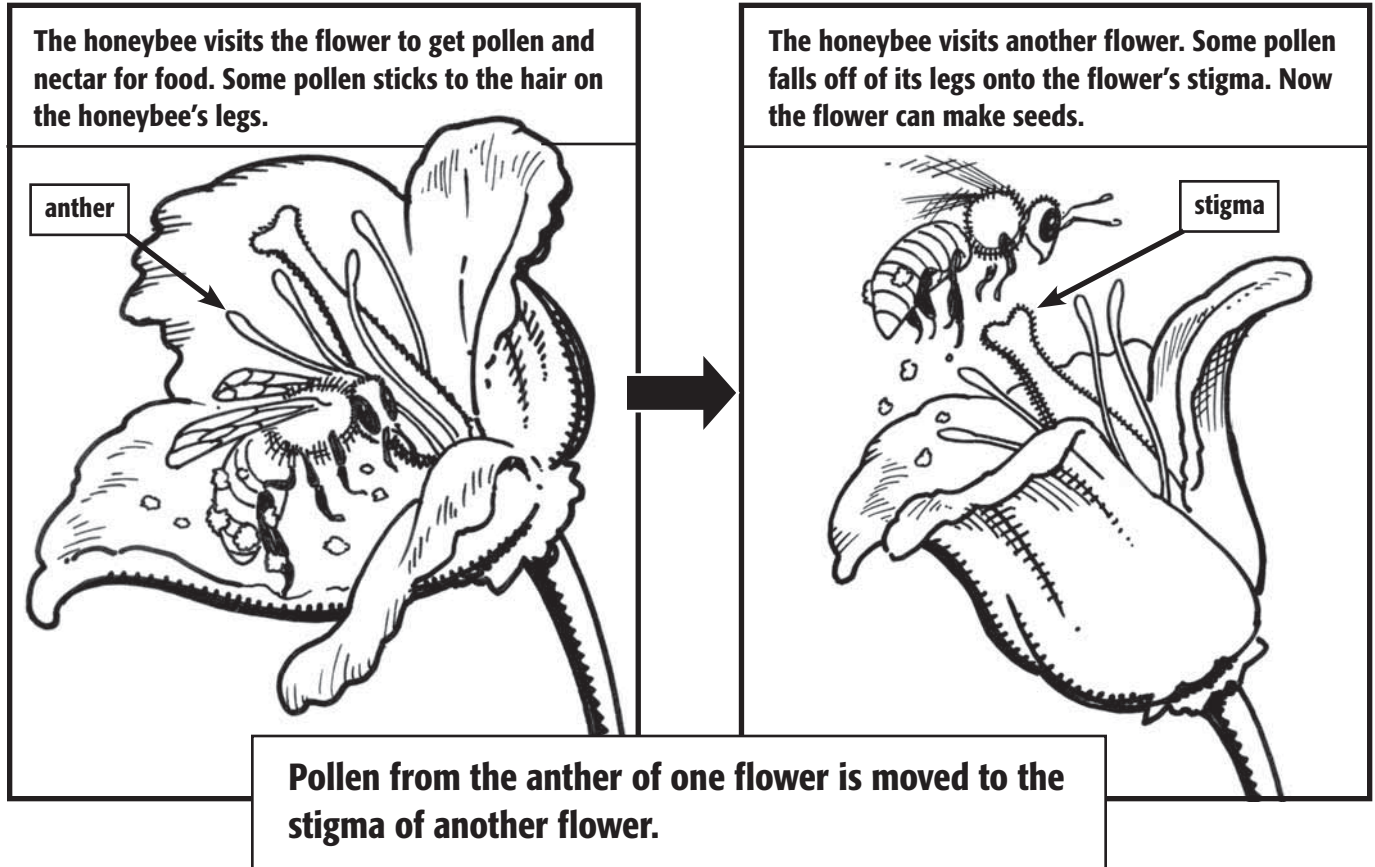


A HONEYBEE'S JOB

Many fruit and vegetable plants are pollinated by honeybees. Look at the diagram to learn how this process works. Then answer the questions below.



1. Which part of the flower provides pollen? _____
2. Where does the pollen need to be taken in order for a flower to make seeds?

3. The hair on a honeybee's hind legs is sometimes called a pollen basket. Why do you think this is?

4. Wind can also move pollen from one flower to another. Which do you think is more efficient at pollinating plants, the wind or the honeybee? Explain your answer.
