



Leaving a Dog at Home Alone

- A dog left home during the day needs your companionship at night. Find time to share a walk or playtime.
- Leave familiar toys outside for a dog left in a fenced yard, kennel or house, so that the dog has the security of a well-known toy.
- Never allow your dog in a swimming pool. Pools with straight sides make it impossible for a dog to climb out. The dog will drown trying to grab the concrete sides of the pool.
