

Another good Indian game is Toss and Catch

You need:

2 pieces of cardboard,
each 5 inches square

A long pencil

Scissors

Tape

Glue

Felt-tip pens in different colors

4 pipe cleaners

2 pieces of yarn, each
as long as your arm



How to do it:

1. Draw a big circle on each piece of cardboard. Make sure the circles are the same size. Now cut them out.
2. Take the pieces of cardboard that are left and cut out two horns.

3. Take one of the circles. Tape the pencil to the edge of it like this.

4. Tape the horns to it like this.

5. Glue the other circle on top—with the pencil and horns in the middle.

6. Color a bull's head or Indian design on each side.
7. Poke a hole in the top—between the two horns—like this.

8. Take two pipe cleaners. Twist them together to make one long pipe cleaner. Bend this into a ring. Twist the ends together like this.

9. Take one piece of yarn. Tie it to the ring like this.

10. Tie the yarn and the ring to the bull's head like this.

11. Hold on to the pencil and jiggle the bull's head so the ring lands on one of the horns.
12. When you get good at catching one ring, take the other pipe cleaners and make another ring. Tie it to the bull's head with the extra piece of yarn. Now try to catch both rings at the same time!
